RESPONSABILITIES

- Lead day-to-day activities for all departments in the plant. Responsible for production planning and efficiency, machine maintenance, safety, certification maintenance and quality in accordance with policies, principles, and established procedures;
- Support the launch of new brands and/or products in China and around the world;
- Manage the export process in collaboration with Foshan office, ensuring compliance and timely delivery;
- Develop and coach direct reports. Set production plans and targets for teams, implement performance management process and lead safety culture;
- Implement the plant vision and growth strategies and report regularly on progress and results;

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- Ensure compliance with applicable governmental/WS regulations related to commercial activities and environmental, health and safety. Implement and/or adapt policies and procedure to ensure safety and compliance;
